Teachers will walk students to the gate at 3.20/3.30pm

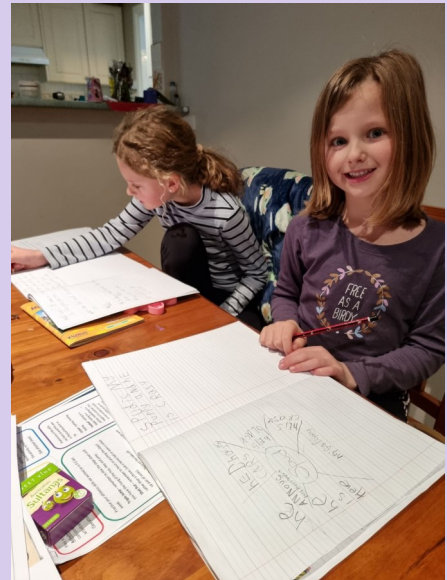

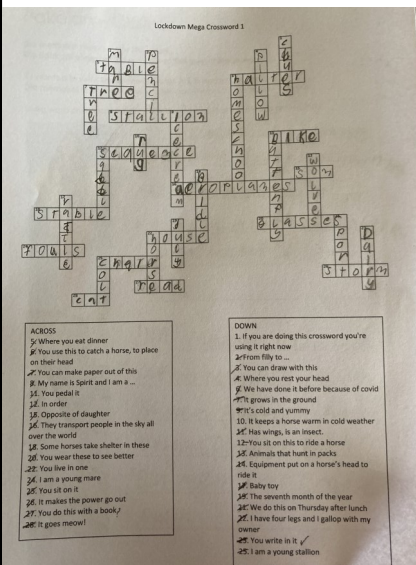

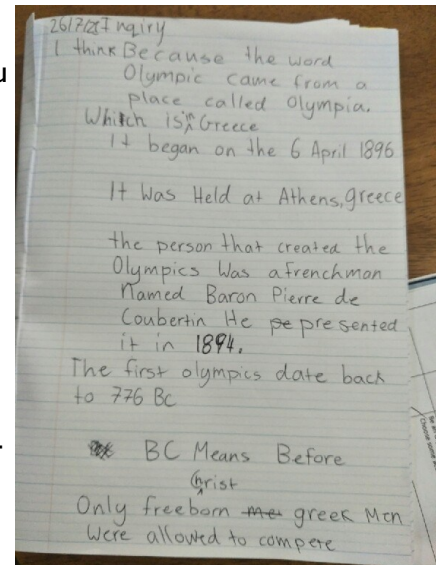
Year 3/4 Class—Mr C
